NOTE!! STUDENTS ARE NOT TO TAKE TESTS OR DO ANY OTHER FORM OF ASSESSMENT UNTIL THE SECTION WORK IS DONE CORRECTLY AND TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE TEACHER. IF THE WORK IS NOT DONE CORRECTLY, THE TESTS AND WRITINGS WON'T BE DONE CORRECTLY EITHER.

SECTION 1: Multiple tests are available to choose from either/all tests ---a comprehensive essay---, Vocabulary tests, etc., Supplemental binders.

SECTION 2: Tests on Franklin's writings, are in the teacher supplemental materials.

SECTION 3: Write an EPISTLE, page 151. In front of the teacher, may use notes.

SECTION 4: Either the Teaching Supplemental materials test or an essay analyzing the poems of William Cullen Bryant.

SECTION 5: There are tests on each of the four authors and their works in the Teaching Supplemental works/materials.

SECTION 6: Tests are available on ALL the authors, with alternate types of assessment available as well.

SECTION 7: Select tests, parts of tests, objective and essay, to use here.

SECTION 8: \*\*\*Suggest here that the paper be the main assessment for this section. Notes and observations, readings and a great thesis essay are a good week's work.

SECTION 9: See teacher's supplemental material for test information. There are several good tests included for these authors.

SECTION 10: Supplemental materials have tests, both objective and essay, that are very good. Also, an oral exam can work here.

SECTION 11: Paper on these three writers, using notes taken, and/or write a test on which the questions require the understanding of the generation and how these authors and their works reflect the times.

SECTION 12: Comprehensive paper on one of the writers whose works have been covered in this unit.

SECTIONS 13, 14, 15: The journal has to be done before any assessments can take place. Have the students write several poems of his or her own, modeling after poems of those studied. Also, prepare a discussion on a favorite poet and/or give a test on the poems chosen by the student to study.

SECTIONS 16, 17, 18: Give tests that are in the teaching materials, or use one from another teacher's guide, etc.
