NOTE: FOUR SEMESTERS ARE REQUIRED FROM THE FOLLOWING CHOICES: Semester A, B, C, D (explanations below), Writing Projects, Literature Into Film, \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_

BOOKS: Semesters B and D are individual titles and are available from the school. WRITER'S INC. and WRITE FOR COLLEGE are available to check out or the books can be purchased from the school. The individual titles can also be purchased, although you may have to go to the local bookstore.

Semester A.....Prentice-Hall American Literature, with teaching materials in the support box. It is important that these tests and the teaching notes and suggestions are used.

Semester C .....Prentice-Hall British Literature, with teaching materials in the support box. It is important that these tests and teaching notes and suggestions are used.

ANSWER KEYS: Are right in the Teacher's Wraparound Books and in the loose leaf support box. **If at all possible, meet with the students individually and go over the exercises and quizzes with them at the time of completion. DISCUSSION IMPROVES UNDERSTANDING..... especially of the literature lessons.**

ASSIGNMENTS: Please refer to the introductory sheet with each semester packet. Since this program is sequential, it is very important to NOT allow the student to skip, omit, delete, go around.....(how else can this be said?) assignments.

PROCEDURES: Introductory pages are given for each semester with basic procedures for the student and the teacher. The teacher needs his/her own book for all question and quiz keys. Essays and essay questions are to be assessed according to the Analytical Rubrics authorized and recognized by the State of Alaska.
