Student Illness Procedures

Student is sent home if you answer “yes” to any 1 of the following:

- Have had close contact with anyone who tested positive for Covid-19 in the last 14 days.
- Have been diagnosed with Covid-19 within the last 10 days.
- Has a COVID test pending.

Sudden (past 24 hrs.) onset of any 1 of the following symptoms:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Abdominal pain, diarrhea, or vomiting
- Loss of taste or smell
- Headache
- Muscle or body aches
- Fever (100.4 + or greater)

Student is sent home if they have 2 or more of any of the following symptoms:

- Sore throat
- Unusual fatigue
- Nausea or vomiting
- Runny nose or nasal congestion
- Cough

Return to School Options

Option 1

Stay home for 10 days after your first symptom or positive test, whichever is earlier.

After 10 days, you may return to school when you have not had a fever in 24 hrs. without fever reducing medicine, as long as your other symptoms are improving.

Option 2

If you test negative, you may return to school once you have not had a fever in 24 hrs. without fever reducing medicine, as long as your other symptoms are improving.

Option 3

If your healthcare provider determines your symptoms are from something else, you may return to school with a note from your provider as long as you have not had a fever in 24 hrs. without fever reducing medicine and your other symptoms are improving.
