7th Grade and New Student Orientation

Students and parents/guardians should attend. ***Please bring enclosed computer forms, use fee (\$20) and transportation agreement.*** Orientation will begin in the commons and then students will have a chance to explore the building, find classrooms, and try out their lockers.

Computer and Internet Use Agreement Forms

Enclosed you will find the Computer and Internet Use Agreement forms. (orange & yellow).  ***These forms along with the \$20 use fee must be signed and turned in order for students to receive their school issued laptops.*** Prior year fees and fines must also be resolved before computer is issued.

8th Graders – Bring signed forms (all sides) and money on first day of school to homeroom.

Schedules and Power School

Enclosed you will find your 1st Quarter schedule. Please bring it with you to orientation and /or your first day of school. On the schedule you will find your Power School sign on information. Sports Physicals will be offered after school on Monday, August 27th and Tuesday, August 28th
In order to participate in any Schoenbar sport a sports physical is required. Physicals are valid for 18 months.



SCHOOL LUNCH & Free and Reduced Lunch

If your child was participating in the Free and Reduced lunch program last year and you would like to participate again, you must reapply for this school year. Pick up a copy of the application at the school office or visit www.kgbsd.org. We encourage all families to apply! Completed applications can be returned to the office and processed by our district office in a few business days.
Regular lunch is \$3.25 reduced lunch is .40 cents.

General School Business and Reminders

After school supervision – If not with a teacher or coach, students must be out of the building by 3:00pm.

Pick-ups – Please DO NOT park in the school’s designated BUS ZONES. Please keep vehicles to the left of the yellow line.

Student Absences – On days that your child will not be in school due to illness, trips, family emergency, etc., we ask that you call the school first thing in the morning, or prior to the first day he/she will be absent. Staying in compliance with our Safe Schools program means the office must make contact with a parent or guardian for every absence.

Student Illness - Please keep in mind that we do not have a registered nurse on duty at anytime. Students who are ill or have a fever need to stay home. If your child becomes ill during the school day, a parent or guardian will be called to make arrangements to take him/her home.

P.E. – If your child is taking P.E. he/she must have non-marking shoes that will be worn in the gym, as well as shorts or sweatpants and a t-shirt for class. All students are required to “dress down” for each class.
