Ms. Jacobson's Third Grade Supply List

- 1 box each of: crayons (24 pack), colored pencils, washable markers
- 4 glue sticks
- 3 packages of Ticonderoga pencils (these are preferable over other brands)
- 1 package of lined (college ruled) paper
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 4 containers of Clorox wipes (these are for after lunch and at the end of the day)
- 1 pack of flair pens (these are for writing and word work, we need lots!)
- 1 reusable water bottle (with name on it)
- 2 one-inch 3 ring binders (please make sure it has pockets on the inside)
- 1 composition book (any color, with name on it)
- 2 spiral-bound notebooks (with name on them)
- 1 backpack (labeled somewhere with name)
- 1 pair of gym shoes (name or initials on the inside)
- 1 pair of earbuds/headphones (name or initials somewhere)

These are just the basics for the year. I may ask throughout the year for other supplies that we may need as a collective. If you have issues or cannot get everything on the list, please do not feel that your child will be unsuccessful without these supplies. **We will be sharing the majority of these items throughout the year, so they will belong to everyone.** Community supplies are in place to help with the seating in our classroom and to encourage students to treat supplies correctly. Please do not bring extra personal items, you will not have a place to put them! The items underlined are personal supplies and need to have a student name on them.

When we come back to school, I will have some items listed for donation. These items range from more glue sticks to snacks for the students. Your child will be given a small tote to contain their coat and backpack. This will prevent the sharing of little critters like lice and bed bugs.
