



**Ketchikan School District Homeless Immunization Waiver Form  
PER Alaska Immunization Requirements**

Alaska Immunization Regulations 4 AAC 06.055, 4 AAC 62.450, and 4 AAC 60.100 require that all children in Alaska public and private schools, certified preschools, and licensed child care facilities be immunized against pertussis (for children less than 7 years of age), diphtheria, tetanus, polio, measles, mumps, rubella, hepatitis A, hepatitis B, varicella (for children in child care facilities and preschools and all students through 6<sup>th</sup> grade beginning June 2009), unless he/she is exempt for medical or religious reasons.

As of Spring 2008, the Alaska Immunization Regulation 4 AAC 06.055 is amended to read:

(g) A homeless child or youth, within the meaning of 42 U.S.C. 11434a(2)(McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act), who does not have a record of the required immunizations, may be provisionally enrolled in a public school program for a period of time not exceeding 30 days if a parent or legal guardian has signed a witnessed statement that the child has received the required immunizations and the child’s immunization records are not immediately available.

If a HOMELESS waiver of up to 30 days is requested, complete the information below and return this form to the school.
